Code of Behavior

Welcome to our annual Beach trip. We expect you to represent your parish and town well during these four days. Recall that you are a witness for your church to all those you come in contact with; we ask you to project an image of Christian consideration, sensitivity and respect to everyone and to the property around you. We are confident you will display the maturity, responsible leadership and character, which have become the trademark qualities of Catholic Youth.

These rules are provided for the safety and integrity of the entire group. The following rules will act as a guideline for your behavior during this week of fun:

- Respect all property, bus, trip sites, etc. Please clean up after yourself.
- The buddy system is enforced at all times. You MUST always be in the company of at least one other member of our group.
- No visiting is permitted in rooms occupied by members of the opposite sex.
- You are not to give your name, room number, phone or address out to anyone on the trip not in our group.
- Respect and obey all chaperones, staff and any adult giving directions during this trip.
- Curfew will be set each night as time warrants. Once the doors have been shut at curfew, they are not to be opened, barring real emergencies, for any reason.
- Safety latches and deadbolts should be used in locking your rooms.
- You are to read the safety information printed inside your hotel room door.
- Valuables should not be brought on the trip at all.
- The contents and any charge made to the room are the responsibility of all members staying in that room and must be paid in full before departing on the last day.
- The purchase, possession or consumption of beer, wine or other alcoholic beverages by minors and the possession or use of illegal drugs by any individual will not be tolerated. Individuals may also be forwarded to local authorities.
- No smoking will be allowed during this trip.
- No weapon of any kind may be possessed by a participant on this trip.
- Room assignments are not to be changed unless all chaperones approve.
- Jumping/Climbing from the balcony is strictly forbidden.
- Throwing any items off of the balcony is strictly forbidden.
- At a sign of illness, you MUST inform one of the chaperones.
- During the week, if safety concerns warrant, the chaperones may impose other rules.

Failure to comply with these rules will mean immediate dismissal from the trip, at the discretion of the Saint Luke's staff. Early return home due to dismissal will be at the parent/guardian's expense with no right of reimbursement for any amount in connection therewith.

For the safety and well being of the whole group, anything you see that is in conflict with the Code of Behavior should be brought to the attention of the chaperones.

Finally . . . We look forward to your cooperation and trust you will have little trouble adhering to this Code of Behavior. The most important thing to remember is that you represent your parish and town and we ask you to project an image of Christian consideration, sensitivity and respect to everyone and to the property around you.
